Vinification	The mighty Vermentino has had a resurgence of interest in the south of France, with many customers preferring it to the ubiquitous Picpoul. The grapes for this beautiful wine are sourced from low hills near the Lagoon overlooking the picturesque tourist spot of Sete, where the cool evenings and mornings improve the grapes natural acidity. The soils are limestone, schist and clay, with some marl to aid drainage. The vines are farmed organically.
