A powerful and complex wine produced from the super-hero grape variety that is Saperavi, also described as the Malbec of the Caucasus.

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### Tasting Notes:

A complex and aromatic bouquet, notes of black cherry and cassis and an underlay of vanilla. Powerful and complex, there is a delicious Malbec like black fruit and olive fruit seam, carried by a super ripe tannin structure.
