Blessed with a perfect south-south-easterly exposure, this 1er Cru is situated to the north of Beaune. Owned by the dukes of Burgundy and highly favoured by the kings of France, the wines of Beaune were regularly served at Versailles. In the 15th century, upon the death of Charles Le Téméraire, the last duke of Burgundy, this clos passed into the hands of the royal winemakers and therefore became Beaune Clos du Roi - the plot of the king. Big, decadent and powerful. Very small quantities available.

Tasting Notes:

Rich, ripe and structured, with great weight of dense red fruits, oak, vanilla and spice. The character of the wine shows a warmth and generous weight of red fruits, with supple easy structure that tightens towards the finish. Layers of complex mineral notes, acidity and green tea. Big, decadent and powerful.
