This cuvée was named in honour of Louis, the brother of Elisabeth Salmon, who was passionate about oenology and highly involved in winemaking from the earliest creation of the House. Sourced from the finest parcels of the Côte des Blancs, this Blanc de Blancs vintage embodies purity and minerality.

Tasting Notes:

With its distinguished elegance, this wine offers an exceptionally precise expression of Chardonnay, showcasing the natural balance and harmony of the region's best Grand Cru vineyards: Cramant and Chouilly for finesse, and Mesnil-sur-Oger for structure and longevity. The nose is complex and refined, with pronounced minerality, floral notes, ripe citrus, and delicate nutty aromas. On the palate, the wine delivers a creamy texture, with beautiful finesse. It offers a refreshing balance of natural flavours, including citrus, biscuit and a hint of white pepper.
