Austria's most popular red grape variety, Blauer Zweigelt is renowned for being reliable, versatile, and approachable. This is wonderfully soft and velvety and very fruity.

Tasting Notes:

This wine has a deep red colour and is very fruity. Aromas of juicy, dark berries, especially ripe cherries and blackberries, dominate the bouquet and continue on the palate. The wine is soft and velvety, with a pleasant, well-integrated acidity that perfectly supports the fruity notes. The full body has a pleasant depth and is complemented by subtle spicy nuances and a delicate woody character. The finish is round and fruity, with a fine balance between freshness and ripeness.

| Producer Overview | <p>This winery is situated in the Weinviertel area of Austria north west of Vienna, close to the border with the Czech Republic. The family has been growing vines in the area since the 17th century but it is only in the last 50 years that the estate has grown from 3 hectares to become the largest winery in Austria with over 190 hectares and tank storage facilities for 12 million litres. This was achieved by Wolfgang Baumgartner and then his son Wieland buying up vineyard land when it was available cheaply and by pursuing a policy of making wines and processing grapes for other companies, including for the 300 members of the local co-operative and they are the largest producers of Weinviertel DAC wines.
