## Bourgogne Hautes Côtes de Beaune 2022, Domaine Machard de Gramont

Produced from south facing vineyards situated just outside the boundary with Pommard, this is a really interesting wine. 3 parcels, the oldest of which are planted with 70 year old vines, are very well positioned and enjoy all day sunshine. The top soil here is very thin, and the average age of the vines is around 40 years old. Alban adds 4% Pinot Beurot (an ancient Burgundian grape similar to Pinot Gris) to the wine to enhance the aromatics.

### Tasting Notes:

A very pretty and charming wine, with seductive sweet red fruits and an almost joyful expression and character. A nice touch of minerality and green sappiness that cuts through the lush sweet fruit. Very approachable already.

Vinification	Alban started picking this vineyard on the 6th September, and the grapes were de-stemmed, crushed and fermentation started almost immediately due to worries about the heat during picking. Aged in 33% new oak
