### Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2023, Domaine Joseph Voillot

Produced from 2 plots, Les Long Bois and Les Grandes Terres, covering approximately 1.3 hectares, the vineyards are situated on the lower slopes in the village of Volnay, with vines that average 60 years old.

#### Tasting Notes:

The nose is incredible! Ripe, sweet and lush, with notes of red and black cherry, damson, an edge of Kirsch and some spice. The tannins are supple and refined with a lovely generous feel and the finish is long in the mouth.
