Produced from 2 plots, Les Long Bois and Les Grandes Terres, covering approximately 1.3 hectares, the vineyards are situated on the lower slopes in the village of Volnay, with vines that average 60 years old.



#### Tasting Notes:

Aromas of baked black hedgerow fruits on the nose and on the palate there is black cherry, smoked blackberry, spice, and a touch of menthol. Rich, dense and textured with excellent depth and concentration, this is a wonderfully appealing Pinot Noir that can be enjoyed immediately but will benefit from 2-5 years of cellaring.
