### Bourgogne Rouge 2021, Domaine Sérafin

Harvested from 2 parcels, a 0.33ha parcel of 45yo vines named Pressonnier, which for 30 years, between 1956 and 1986, had the right to be sold as Gevrey-Chambertin. There is also a proportion of grapes added from young vines of the 1er Cru Cazetieres, which gives a greater complexity to the wine. In 2021 they made just 4 barrels – down from their normal 17-18.

#### Tasting Notes:

Vinified in 50% new oak, this fragrant and attractive Pinot shows a lovely smoky, jammy and ripe fruit, offering cherry, raspberry and some spice, with softish tannins and a lovely freshness and minerality. Overall the wine shows weight and a distinct savoury quality that leads to a long finish. Very classy – a mini Gevrey!
