This steep, south, south east facing vineyard looking over the village of Milly and just above Dampt's home, is set on a stony clay subsoil and enjoys a great aspect. The fruit normally shows a great degree of ripeness and generosity. In such hot years, this left bank vineyard benefits from the shade. There is always a lot of millerandage (small grapes) in this vineyard which produces great concentration, and aids long ageing.

Tasting Notes:

Always a very overt, rich and ripe style of wine, there is a beautiful purity and concentration of fruit, coupled with a piecing lime acidity and a long succulent and tropical fruit finish. An outstanding 1er Cru.
