The smallest of the Grand Cru vineyards, A small plot of only 0.31 ha planted with 53 year old vines. 80% of this wine is fermented in steel tank with the remaining 20% in 600 litre oak barrels.

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of ripe apples, honey and a dash of underlying oak. The palate is complex and rich, with overtones of honeycomb and butter, balanced by a quenching mineral acidity. The oak supports the wine well and the finish boasts the steeliness and austerity of a great Grand Cru Chablis.
