The small Clos of St Jean lies directly above the village on slopes that adjoin Vergers, and was historically placed alongside some of the great red wine appellations such as Vosne-Romanée, Corton and Romanée-St. Vivant. Amiot's 0.25 ha plot of 60 year old vines lies in the central part of the gentle slope with good southern aspect.

Tasting Notes:

A rich, ripe and balanced Pinot Noir, offering rich structure and tremendously elegant and satisfying fruit quality. There is red cherry, raspberry and a hint of cranberry, balanced by streaks of fresh acidity, sweet oak, spice and a polished silky tannin structure. Big finish – the tannins turn mighty at the end.
