



## HOUSE OF TOWNEND

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### Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Caillerets 2024, Domaine Guy Amiot et Fils 6x75cl

The steeper slopes of Caillerets, strewn with lumps of limestone and pebbles, lie beside the winery on the southern aspect of the village and benefit from the afternoon sun. Amiot's 0.5 hectare is split between 2 parcels, one 86 years old the other a mere 48! A true expression of Chassagne identity this wine combines power, elegance, and unmistakable character, standing apart from the more linear modern style.

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#### Tasting Notes:

Ripe and expressive, this wine is layered with honeyed, toasty, and tropical fruit aromas framed by intense citrusy lemon acidity and a wet stone minerality. On the palate it is sumptuous and powerful, with complex layers of white peach and stone fruits and a creamy, voluminous texture that coats the mouth. Mouthwatering acidity runs from start to finish balancing the richness with precision and lift. A true expression of Chassagne identity this wine combines power, elegance, and unmistakable character, standing apart from the more linear modern style.
