This very popular Classed Growth Pauillac, one of the oldest estates in the Médoc, is the family Castéja's and Borie-Manoux's flagship. An outstanding wine this vintage.

Tasting Notes:

A classic Pauillac, powerful, muscular and intense. The bouquet is fragrant with a touch of graphite and underlay of cedar oak. The palate is sturdy with firm tannins, the intensity of blackcurrant fruit is so impressive with smouldering tobacco and smoke giving added dimension. A multilayered wine of great breeding.

Vinification	Vinification takes place in a total of 60, temperature controlled stainless steel vats that vary in size from 110 hectoliters to 130 hectoliters. The vats do not vary much in size, as the majority of parcels are quite similar in size at close to 1 hectare per parcel. Malolactic fermentation takes place in vat. On average, the wine is aged in 50% new, French oak barrels for between 16 to 18 months.
