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## Château Beychevelle 2015, 4ème Cru Classé Saint-Julien

One of the most enjoyable wines this vintage - the higher proportion of Merlot giving a stunning richness with layer upon layer of creamy chocolate and cassis flavours. Château Beychevelle's vineyards are located in the far south of the St-Julien appellation and has the reputation of producing generally forward wine, supple and rich, which gives approachable, early drinking pleasure.

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### **Tasting Notes:**

Appealing, perfumed Parma violet bouquet, dense fruit structure with opulence and sweet notes of toasted oak. Stunning richness with layer upon layer of creamy chocolate and cassis flavours with a little cedar oak adding character. A very impressive, harmonious and supple Claret.
