Château Beychevelle is one of the most visually striking estates in the Médoc, historically linked to the Duke of Épernon and the “baisse-voile” legend that gave the château its ship emblem identity. A 4th Growth Saint-Julien, it combines the commune’s hallmark elegance with a polished, almost aristocratic sense of style. It is defined by supple fruit, fine tannins and a lifted aromatic profile of blackcurrant, violet, and cedar. Careful modern winemaking has added precision and freshness, giving the wine both structure and clarity without losing its silky texture. The result is a refined, accessible expression of Saint-Julien that balances charm, depth and finesse rather than overt power.

Tasting Notes:

A rich yet elegant expression of Beychevelle, precise and complex, brimming with generous sweet black and red fruits, raspberry, black cherry and a touch of liquorice. Voluptuous and generous, even exotic, showing great fruit intensity balanced by a beguiling freshness and purity. The tannins are plush and a touch of cedar lingers in the mouth.
