Château Canon is a historic estate located on the limestone plateau just outside the medieval village of Saint-Émilion, one of the most prized terroirs in Bordeaux. The vineyards benefit from south and south west facing slopes with excellent drainage and a strong limestone influence that lends precision and freshness to the wines. The property spans roughly 34 hectares and is planted mainly with Merlot as well as a significant proportion of Cabernet Franc. Since 1996, it has been owned by the Wertheimer family through the Chanel group, which has invested heavily in vineyard restructuring and cellar modernisation.

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of crushed black cherry, wild raspberry and violet followed by more subtle layers of graphite, fennel and damp stone. The palate is remarkably poised. Silky yet taut with finely powdered tannins carrying waves of red and blue fruit across a mineral laced core. Hints of iris, cocoa, cracked pepper and chalk emerge gradually giving the wine both energy and restraint. There is a quiet intensity here, driven by purity, tension and extraordinary persistence. The finish lingers with stony freshness and a delicate edge that reflects Canon's limestone soils.
