Overlooking both Cheval Blanc and Pétrus, this is a beautifully located, family owned château that produces outstanding, affordable claret.



Tasting Notes:

This is a hidden jewel of a Château, offering some of the finest value for money on the Right Bank. Aged in 40% old barrels and 60% in tank, Jacques Rambaud includes a small proportion of Malbec in the blend, which is co-fermented with Cabernet Franc. Packed with intense, stewed plums and ripe mulberry fruits, this is so suave and fruity. There is a lovely velvety feel to the palate with a crunchy freshness and mineral edge and the tannins are beautifully polished. This wine is a wonderful representation of the terroir and character of Montagne-Saint Emilion.
