This 49 hectare estate has recently been in outstanding form to maintain its reputation as a 'Super Second Growth'. Another superb expression of this renowned Saint-Julien estate, made with remarkable precision and elegance under Bruno Borie's meticulous direction. Layers of cassis, blackberry and fresh raspberry are complemented by floral notes, graphite, cedar and subtle spice, whilst polished tannins and vibrant freshness carry through to a long, refined finish.

Tasting Notes:

Ducru-Beaucaillou has produced a remarkable wine of precision and elegance in 2025, balancing layers of cassis, blackberry and fresh raspberry with floral lift, graphite and subtle spice. The palate is structured yet refined, combining polished tannins, vibrant acidity and beautifully integrated oak, whilst notes of cedar, cocoa and savoury herbs lead to a long, poised finish of exceptional freshness and depth.
