



## HOUSE OF TOWNEND

### Château Fuissé 1er Cru Le Clos Monopole 2023

A monopole of just 2.68ha situated in an amphitheatre around the Château itself, and separated into 3 soils types – clay at the bottom, marl in the middle and fragmentated limestone at the top. The vines were planted in 1929, 1963, 1968 and the most recent in 1985.

#### Tasting Notes:

The nose is incredibly intense and complex, peach and cream, mango, cereal and integrated oak, all with a tension and tautness that is startling. Amazing!
