



## HOUSE OF TOWNEND

### Château Fuissé 1er Cru Le Clos Monopole 2024 6 x 75cl

A monopole of just 2.7 hectares, this vineyard forms an amphitheatre around the Château and is divided into three distinct soil types—clay at the bottom, marl in the middle, and fragmented limestone at the top. The vines, planted in 1929, 1963, 1968, and 1985, benefit from a warm aspect, free draining soils, and a rare underground water source, all were all beneficial in 2024.

#### Tasting Notes:

The nose is rich and exotic, with opulent notes of honeysuckle, Granny Smith apple and almonds. On the palate, this is a big, powerful wine, with intense acidity and vibrant freshness providing focus and a cleansing lift that cuts through the decadent fruit and oak. Flavours of toasty apple and energetic, lively fruit carry through to a long, elegant finish.
