Tasting Notes:

This is Gruaud Larose's 300th anniversary vintage and what a wine to celebrate with! This is a big, dark, cassis driven claret, showing richness, concentrated red and black fruits, a hint of bell pepper, coffee and liquorice. Supple tannins support a core of richly sweet fruit – very polished throughout, and showing energy and a lovely freshness and elegant structure.
