Château Lafite-Rothschild is one of Bordeaux's most revered First Growth estates. Rooted in the gravel rich soils of Pauillac, its reputation stretches back centuries, with the estate becoming a symbol of aristocratic luxury after gaining prominence in European royal courts during the 18th century. Owned by the Rothschild family since 1868, Château Lafite balances deep tradition with meticulous vineyard management and modern winemaking discipline.

Tasting Notes:

The bouquet is intense and powerful with aromas of ripe cassis and wild strawberry freshness. The palate smoulders, driven by impossibly fine tannins that feel etched rather than pressed, carrying cool black fruits, cigar leaf and wet slate across a frame that shows a remarkable purity. Rich yet resonant and beautifully precise, this is a classic Lafite full of black fruit concentration with supporting flavours of cedar smoke, graphite and an impressive mineral tension.
