### Château Lamothe-Bergeron 2020, Haut-Médoc

This château is located to the south of St Julien on a plot of high land, the 'motte', and has been owned by the Cognac H Mounier Group since 2009. The property is run by Mery Laurent, who is supported in the winemaking process by Hubert de Bouard of Château Angelus.

#### Tasting Notes:

Wonderfully aromatic with classic claret forest floor notes. The palate is beautifully balanced, with succulent sweet ripe black fruits, cassis and black cherry, a delicious freshness, graphite and lead and a superb tannin structure. The finish is long, beautiful and seasoned, with lingering flavours of Belgian chocolate, raspberry coulis and cinnamon.
