This 20 hectare estate is the 'sister' to Léoville Barton and one of three Châteaux owned by Lilian Barton and her family.

Tasting Notes:

Fresh and fragrant, there is a lovely whiff of prune and freshly picked blackberries. Tightly knit and medium weight, there is a core of red and black fruits with finely tuned tannins and a dose of cedar that lends a savoury edge. A punchy percentage of Merlot provides a bouncy boost of plum fruit. A beautifully balanced, stylish wine.
