This 20 hectare estate is the 'sister' to Léoville Barton and one of three Châteaux owned by Lilian Barton and her family. The quality produced at this property has been consistently very high for many years now.

Tasting Notes:

A small estate of just 18ha and planted to 5 main blocks, this is a jewel in the Barton crown, making exemplary St Julien. Always forward, classy and elegant, this is a cracking 2025, rich and very ripe nose, appealing with notes of mulled red fruits, plum, cherry and a hint of spice. The palate is rich yet not overly concentrated, moreish and svelte with a delicious succulent mouthfeel and fruit quality with a touch of bergamot on the finish.
