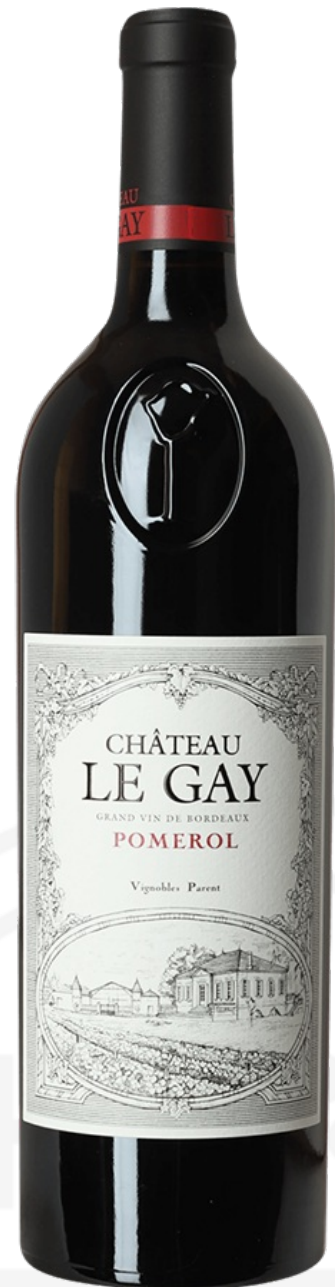
Le Gay is on top form in recent years. A massive, powerful, hedonistic wine displaying a stunning complexity.
