Leoville-Barton is one of the most consistent, high performers of the St Julien appellation, always producing beautifully constructed and tightly knit wine.

Tasting Notes:

A wine of stunning intensity. The nose is powerful, intense and brooding with notes of black fruits and liquorice leading to a palate that is oozing pure cassis fruits, underpinned by a refined note of cedar oak and a streak of graphite, wrapped around a robust structure with perfectly poised ripe tannin. Concentrated and harmonious with a very long on the finish, this is a top Leoville-Barton.
