One of the top estates in Saint-Estèphe, Château Montrose produces powerful, classically structured wines that often rival the First Growths. Its style combines depth and authority with a striking sense of freshness and balance. The bouquet shows blackcurrant, plum, and violet, layered with graphite, cedar and subtle hints of truffle and smoke. On the palate it is full bodied and firmly structured, with polished tannins supporting a concentrated core of dark fruit. A fine line of freshness lifts the wine, whilst notes of oak spice and minerality carry through a long, focused finish built for ageing.

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of blackcurrant, plum and violet with an underlay of graphite, cedar and subtle traces of truffle and smoke. On the palate it is full bodied and structured, with firm but polished tannins framing a concentrated core of dark fruit. A line of freshness brings lift and clarity, whilst fine oak spice and mineral notes extend through a long, focused finish. Elegant, muscular and built for long ageing, it shows both intensity and balance in equal measure.

It was bought in 2006 by the Bouygues family and in recent years an astonishing investment programme has been carried out at the château. Now under the stewardship of Herve Berland, formerly at Mouton Rothschild, this château continues to compete at the very highest level. With only 37% of the crop used in this year's first wine at this château, only the very best fruit has been included in the blend. It is an outstanding result and undoubtedly amongst the finest in the commune, if not the vintage.</p> |
