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# Château Mouton Rothschild 2025, 1er Cru Classé, Pauillac 6x75cl

The 2025 Château Mouton Rothschild is one of the stars of the vintage. Produced with a whopping 98% Cabernet Sauvignon and produced in significantly reduced quantities, this First Growth combines power, precision and poise.



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### Tasting Notes:

Deep, concentrated and beautifully composed, the 2025 Mouton Rothschild opens with aromas of crème de cassis, blueberry, violet and cigar box, layered with notes of mocha, espresso and exotic spice. The palate is rich yet remarkably controlled, showcasing the vintage's outstanding Cabernet Sauvignon through its freshness, precision and finely tuned structure. Powerful and persistent, with impressive depth and a long, mouthwatering finish, this is a Mouton of great elegance that promises both early appeal and exceptional ageing potential.

<b>Producer Overview</b>	<p>Chateau Mouton Rothschild dates back to the 1730's. In 1853 Baron Nathaniel de Rothschild bought the vineyard of Mouton in the Medoc and it was re-named Mouton Rothschild. It was classified as a second growth wine until 1973 when it was promoted to first growth status. The wines stand out from other Bordeaux wines as for each vintage, a well-known artist is commissioned to design a new label, making the wine very collectable. The vineyards total 75 hectares producing around 25,000 cases with plantings of 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc and 2% Petit Verdot.</p>
