# Château Olivier 2021 Grand Cru Classé, Pessac-Leognan

Classified for its red and white wines, Château Olivier is surrounded by forest that not only influences the property's micro-climate, but which has given it 8 hectares of prime vineyard, already in the Pessac-Léognan AOC. A detailed geological survey in 2003 revealed the forest was planted on a croupe of compact gravel, perfect for Cabernet Sauvignon.

### Tasting Notes:

Yielded at a relatively small 41hl/ha, and aged for 12 months in 1/3 new oak barrels, this vintage of Olivier shows a lovely fresh and raspberry-scented claret, with an underlying streak of sweet cherry and mocha. There is elegance in abundance, some ripe and chunky tannins, but these melt toward the finish. Long, elegant and refined.
