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# Château Olivier Rouge 2025, Grand Cru Classé, Pessac- Leognan 6x75cl

Owned by the Bethmann family since the 19th century, Château Olivier is one of only six estates in Bordeaux classified for both its red and white wines in the historic 1953 Graves Classification. Nestled in the heart of Pessac-Léognan, the estate has steadily refined its style through meticulous vineyard work and organic farming practices. Its gravelly terroir produces wines marked by freshness, precision and understated elegance. The reds combine ripe dark fruit with smoky minerality, whilst the whites are prized for their vibrancy and aromatic lift. Château Olivier is one of the appellation's most consistent and quietly rising properties.

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### Tasting Notes:

A very deep garnet hue and a highly expressive nose, blending notes of cocoa, dark fruits, and rose. On the palate, there is a remarkable concentration of texture that remains velvety, refreshed by hints of crushed raspberry. The lingering finish suggests excellent aging potential.
