One of Bordeaux's most celebrated 3rd Growth châteaux, renowned for producing wines that rival 1st Growth quality through elegance, perfume and texture rather than sheer power. Located in the heart of Margaux, the estate is known for its unusually high proportion of Merlot, which gives its wines a signature plushness and sensual, floral character.

### Tasting Notes:

A supreme wine at Palmer this vintage. The bouquet is a moreish wave of blackberry preserve, rich and dreamy. The palate is opulent with cassis and plum fruits, a touch of clove and espresso coffee that glides beneath the fruit construct and seductively ripe tannins supporting the firm structure. There is a lingering mineral freshness and a refined savoury edge on the finish.

<b>Producer Overview</b>	In 1938, four Bordeaux families – Sichel, Mähler-Besse, Ginestet, and Mialhe – all active in the Bordeaux fine wine trade – joined together to buy Palmer and restore it to the rank it deserved.
