Château Phelan Segur 2021, St Estephe

Founded by Irishman Bernard Phélan and then developed by his son, Frank, Château has been one of the benchmarks of the St-Estephe appellation since the 19th Century. Bordering Château Montrose and Château Calon-Ségur, it is situated on well drained gravel soils and produces wonderful claret.

Tasting Notes:

2021 yielded only 32hl/ha with the highest proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon ever, accounting for 75% of the blend. An attractive fresh bouquet with notes of raspberry and red cherry and a lovely fragrance of rose petals. The palate is deep and finely constructed, punching well above its station, with fresh cassis fruits, a hint of tobacco and forest floor, all supported by finely polished tannins.
