Founded by Irishman Bernard Phélan and then developed by his son, Frank, this Château has been one of the benchmarks of the Ste-Estephe appellation since the 19th Century. Bordering Château Montrose and Château Calon-Ségur, it is situated on well drained gravel soils and produces wonderful claret.



Tasting Notes:

There is a lovely overt ripeness on the nose with a whiff of pencil shaving. Rich and creamy in texture there is also a wonderful refined freshness as well as perfectly poised and polished tannins. The finish is long with a delicious lingering note of black fruits.
