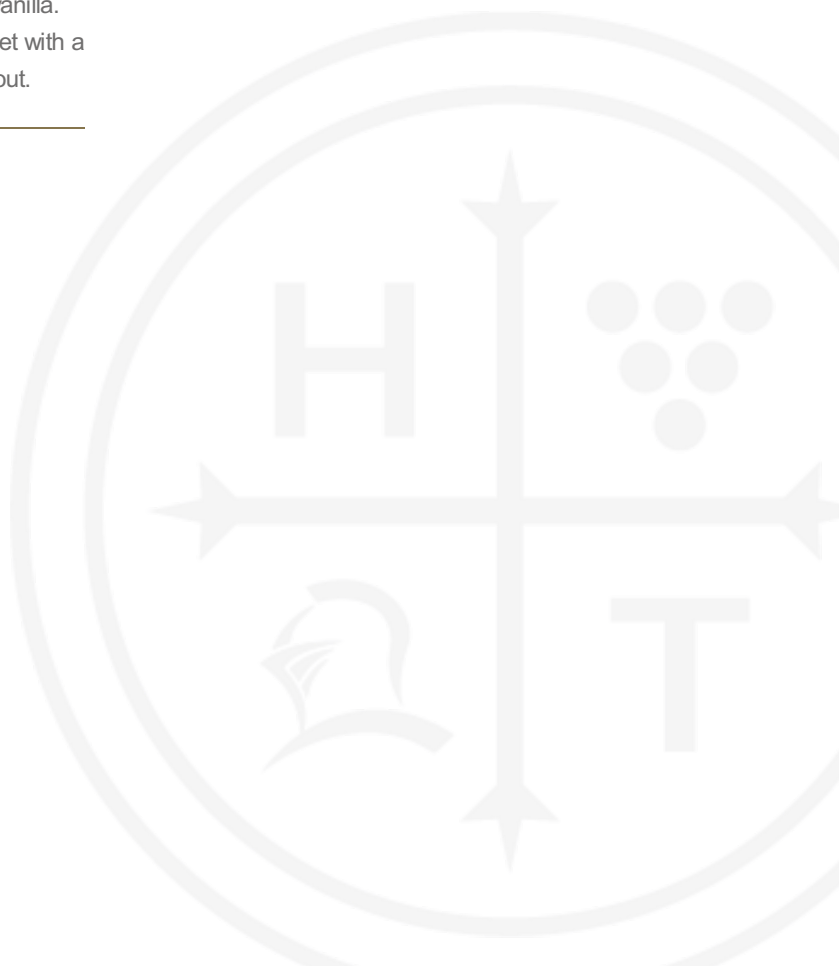

This is one of the great Châteaux of Bordeaux and is rightly one of the most sought after Second Growths, with a reputation for producing wines that are typically Pauillac. This is one of the stars of the vintage – refined, classic and complex.

Tasting Notes:

Rich and refined black and red fruits and a touch of cedar on the nose. The palate is rich with layers of cherry, cassis and vanilla. Spice aplenty, integrated with ripe tannins, concentrated yet with a lovely elegance and poise. Fresh acidity supports throughout.

Vinification	Harvest took place from 22nd September through to 9th October, with low yields of around 30hl/ha and 52% of the crop going into the grand vin. Lighter extraction was used for this vintage and the result is an impressively balanced Pichon Comtesse. Will be aged in 66% new oak
