Situated in the Haut-Médoc near Château Citran, Margaux, this sturdy petit-château claret is made from old vines, which grow on gravelly soil, and whose grapes are harvested by hand.

Tasting Notes:

Classic claret aromas of black fruit, cedar, graphite, and green tea, lifted by notes of sweet red cherry and mocha. The 2024 is already open and stylish, with ripe fruit at the core, supple tannins, and a poised, elegant finish.
