Château Suduiraut is one of Sauterne's most historic estates, renowned for its deep connection to the region's tradition of noble sweet wines. Classified as a Premier Cru in the 1855 Classification, the property has long been recognised for the quality and consistency of its vineyard holdings. The estate is owned by AXA Millésimes, whose stewardship has focused on preserving the château's heritage while refining vineyard and cellar practices. Surrounded by meticulously maintained gardens inspired by those of Versailles, Château Suduiraut combines architectural elegance with an exceptional terroir at the heart of Sauternes.

Tasting Notes:

A wonderful bouquet with aromatics that combine ripe fruit and delicate floral tones with deeper nuances of roasted and candied notes. The palate is beautifully balanced, opening with a supple, almost unctuous texture followed by concentrated botrytised fruit and a vibrant, mouth watering acidity that brings lift and precision. There are flavours of honey and orange peel and whilst the mouthfeel is very intense it also remains beautifully pure and refined. A wine of remarkable finesse and layered complexity.

Technical Director, Pierre Montégut, who has been at Suduiraut since 2004, is responsible for producing some of the estates' finest wines, known for their intensity, balance, complexity and ageing potential.
