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### Château Talbot 2022, 4ème Grand Cru Classé Saint-Julien

One of the most popular En Primeur châteaux, always delivering a wine true to its appellation.

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#### Tasting Notes:

This is arguably the finest wine produced by this Château this century. Aged in 60% new oak, the bouquet broods with deep, rich black fruits and a smouldering smokiness. The palate is broad, succulent with a velvety, creamy texture and brimming with layer upon layer of powerful black fruits, forest floor and notes of cedar intertwined with the perfectly poised tannins. A fantastic wine with freshness and balance on the finish.

Vinification	Château Talbot is vinified in a combination of temperature controlled, large, truncated, wood vats and stainless steel tanks. The stainless steel tanks are used only for the young vines. The wine of Château Talbot is then aged in 60% new, French oak barrels for an average of 14-16 months. Yields in 2022 were 40hl/ha.
