The flagship wine of this leading domaine is instantly recognizable in character. It is sourced from 12 distinct vineyard parcels, averaging 50 year old vines, spread across 6 hectares of clay and stony soils on both the northern and southern sides of the village. Each parcel is vinified and matured individually before the final blend is assembled after barrel tasting



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#### Tasting Notes:

The bouquet yields a beautiful, fragrant raspberry freshness. The palate is rich and fruity with mulled black and red forest fruits, a touch of spice and succulent tannins. This wine is full of energy and tension leading to a long and explosive finish.
