A succulent and delicious style of Pinot Noir sourced from three plots around the village of Chorey itself, totalling 1.30 hectares. The vines, averaging 40 years of age, are planted on loam and clay soils with a high proportion of pebbles and fragmented limestone.

### Tasting Notes:

The bouquet is soft and fragrant with sweet berry aromas balanced by cranberry and raspberry freshness. On the palate, the wine is fresh and juicy with crunchy red and black fruit and a rounded, concentrated mid-palate. Fine tannins and good acidity give a feminine character, complemented by a touch of spice and subtle sweet vanilla oak.
