

## Crozes-Hermitage 'Clos des Grives' 2017, Domaine Combier

Price Code £46.99 CROZ455

Produced from a 9½ hectare Clos (walled vineyard) this is Laurent Combier's top cuvée. The oldest 4 hectares of the Clos are planted with vines that date back to 1952 and yield very small quantities. This is a quite sensational wine that will repay ageing.

## Tasting Notes:

Intense, cassis concentrate is rounded by careful oak ageing and overtones of wood smoke, with beautiful finely woven tannins giving added support.
