On the nose aromas of white stone fruit with balanced minerality and a touch of asparagus. The palate has great length, showing green fig and gooseberry flavours.

<b>Vinification</b>	After sorting, destemming and crushing, 50% of the grapes had skin contact for 6 to 12 hours. Only the free-run juice were used for this wine. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and left on the lees for 2 months.
