The Plaisir Exotique Chardonnay has a beautiful yellow colour and displays an exceptional marrying of exotic and stone fruit.

Tasting Notes:

Straw yellow in colour. Aromas of grapefruit, peach and lime. On the palate, intense peach flavour with complimentary exotic fruit notes. Fresh, silky and well balanced.

Vinification	"Plaisir Exotique" is made from 100% Chardonnay, and the grapes come from fields in l'Herault - not far from Montpellier. The vines stand on a terroir that alternates between granite, clay and limestone soil. After the grapes are harvested, they are cooled to a temperature of 8 to 10 degrees to maintain aromas and freshness in the wine.
