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| Vinification | "Plaisir Exotique" is made from 100% Chardonnay, and the grapes come from fields in l'Herault - not far from Montpellier. The vines stand on a terroir that alternates between granite, clay and limestone soil. After the grapes are harvested, they are cooled to a temperature of 8 to 10 degrees to maintain aromas and freshness in the wine. |
