## Specification

**Vinification** Grapes were harvested at full ripeness between 24, 5° - 26,5°B from a selection of vineyards. Malolactic fermentation took place in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks. Wine was matured on wood for 4 months to add weight and complexity before stabilization and bottling.
