It is almost unfair to refer to this wine as the second wine of Ducru Beaucaillou. The grapes for this wine come from the central part of the St Julien commune close to Leoville Barton. Quite outstanding.

Tasting Notes:

Deeply coloured , a super fragrant bouquet, and a serious core of concentrated and creamy black fruits. Myrtle, ironstone and coffee are encased in a band of sweet oak that slips away to reveal a finish of velvet-like sweetness and delicacy. A great claret that will give excellent drinking.
