Low yielding vines and the clay soils of Marlborough's Southern Valleys has produced this excellent Pinot Noir, which displays lifted cherry and raspberry aromas, fragrant vanilla and mocha notes derived from maturation of a portion of the wine in a mixture of new and older French oak barriques.

Tasting Notes:

Bright raspberry and cherry aromas and flavours, with subtle vanilla and cinnamon notes. The palate is supple and elegant with a light dusting of tannins.
