| <b>Vinification</b>      | The winemaking process for Les Chant de Roses is all about preserving and enhancing the harvested grapes freshness and aroma. Grapes are collected early in the morning while temperatures are low. The grapes are destemmed and pressed in a pneumatic press in order to preserve the grape quality. Maceration takes place for a couple of days at very low temperatures. The alcoholic fermentation is slow using low temperatures in stainless steel tanks. The wine stays on its fine lees for three months, gaining its velvety texture.   |
