From a small 0.152 hectare plot west of the village, purchased by Etienne's grandfather in the late 1970s, the vines are 44 years old. Located near the Premier Cru Les Cras, the site benefits from morning sun. In 2024, just two barrels were produced.

#### Tasting Notes:

The nose is immediately appealing, with rich aromas of beeswax, honey and lemon. The palate is unctuous and layered, offering ripe dessert apple, honey, mineral notes, and subtle oak. The finish is bright, citric, and refreshing. This is a beautifully balanced and decadent Meursault, full of class and finesse.
